In consideration of the permission granted to the above Participant by the City of Prairie Grove and Washington County Civic League to participate in youth baseball, I voluntarily sign this PARENTAL RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT. In signing this agreement, I understand that my child will be participating in baseball/softball games. I also understand there are intrinsic hazards connected to such activities, including, but not limited to: injury from another participant; and accidental injury, both foreseeable and unforeseeable. I UNDERSTAND THAT AS A CONSEQUENCE OF RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS TOURNAMENT, THAT MY CHILD MAY SUFFER SERIOUS INJURIES UP TO AND INCLUDING DEATH.

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION**

Understanding all the above risks of injury and that those and other risks (including travel) are the ordinary risk associated with the participation in basketball tournaments, I hereby RELEASE, DISCHARGE, AND AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the instructors, coaches, volunteers, drivers and/or property owners where the events and practices are held for the youth baseball program, including the City of Prairie Grove and Washington County Civic League, from and against all liabilities, claims, demands, and judgments which my child may have or I may have on his/her behalf, or which his/her heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns may have or claim to have against the instructors, coaches, volunteers, drivers, and/or property owners where events and practices are held for the tournament, for all personal injuries including the possibility of death, known or unknown arising out of this educational and recreational program.

I further recognize that neither the City of Prairie Grove nor the Washington County Civic League is providing any sort of injury or health insurance coverage and that any injuries that occur shall be my sole responsibility.

**Washington County Civic League**

Washington County Civic League baseball is an organization of many volunteers. It is an organization that was created to offer an opportunity for the youth in our area to play the nation's favorite pastime, baseball. It is the responsibility of the league coordinators, officials, volunteer coaches, parents, fans and players to create and maintain an environment where the players can compete, experience success, and have fun. Baseball is a game of sportsmanship, skill and fun. The people involved in our activities should not have to fear abuse and embarrassment that some bring to the ball games. We are models of how our children should live their lives and sometimes this is forgotten in the heat of battle.

In today's society, our children are surrounded by more violence and at an ever increasing rate. We must preserve the sanctity of the baseball fields on which or being involved in any league activities we must act now in order to avoid what we are seeing in our schools and on playing fields around the country. In order for your child to be a participant in the Washington County Civic League, all parents must sign an agreement and it must be returned to your local coordinator. Your child will not be able to practice or play until it has been received.

Please understand that we are attempting to protect everyone that is involved in any league activity. Any report of violation of this agreement will be brought in front of the league coordinators and will be dealt with in a severe, but just, manner.
